After School Internship at Stillwater Natives Nursery

Dates: September 23 - December 14, 2024

Schedule is 6 hours a week for one Semester. Options are either 1.25 hrs a day for four days a week or alternatively, 6 hours on a Saturday.

Stipend of \$800.00 upon completion of internship.

Position Description:

Intern will assist in all aspects of Stillwater Natives Nursery, including the use of proper horticultural practices for native plants (planting, pruning, weed management, and irrigation), renovation and construction of new gardens, and public education.

Students will gain practical experience and have a window into career areas that are growing with the need for restoration and sustainable landscaping. The nursery will provide experiences beyond what can be created in the classroom. Over one semester interns will receive quality training, learn many new skills, and receive academic credit.

Skills you will learn:

- Propagation of native plants, transplanting plants, planting seeds, plant cuttings
- Weeding and watering of natives
- Learning to identify many species
- Assist with set-up of new grow areas at nursery.
- Engage in a service-learning projects that is related to native plants in some way (i.e. add native plants to a non-profit landscape, grow native flowers for the City Park, make a walking map of a native plant walk, etc.).
- Write a few sentences each week about what you did at the nursery in a journal.

Skills or strengths needed:

- Comfortable working outside
- Ability to lift 30 pounds
- Good communication skills, in person and remotely
- Plant knowledge helpful but not critical.
